Calumet Christian School was started to provide parents with an opportunity to educate their child(ren) in academics, character, and biblical values within a loving and safe environment. The middle school and high school classes use a variety of Christian-based curriculum to prepare the students both academically and spiritually for college life and adulthood. CCS offers a number of diploma options and offers dual credit courses to transfer into their first year of college. At CCS, not only is the Bible taught as a subject in all grade levels, but more importantly it is the standard through which we teach students to view life. The Early/Aftercare program makes it possible for a full day of care from 7:00 a.m. until 5:15 p.m. for those that need it.
